Goals and Objectives

Goals:

- To establish a living space in an old Townhouse basement replacing an existing office space with a living space to accommodate a nanny/housekeeper.
- Insure that the space can be reused with minimal changes, after the need for a nanny no longer exists

Objectives:


- Provide a living/sleeping area
- Provide an area to create/reheat meals
- Provide a nominal bathroom
- Create the space so that it would easily accommodate other uses after the nanny leaves.

Potentially this could be:

- o Recreation room for older children
- o Office space for the parent(s)
- o An in-law suite
- o A teenagers first "apartment" experience, or more private quarters for a young college age student.
- Although regular access to the space is being abandoned by the homeowner, there is a laundry area and garage entrance that currently exists see if it can be preserved as a space for all to access.




Existing Floor Plan






Proposed Floor Plan






The Design in 3D
